



Daniel Bouland - Morgon Corcelette

Vineyard

The Morgon appellation is divided into 6 lieux-dits, of which "Corcelette" is one, the other 5 being the famous "Côte du Py", "Les Charmes", "Grands-Cras", "Douby" and "Micouds". Daniel Bouland, owner of a 9-hectare estate, is a conscientious winegrower. He is guided by a deep understanding of good grapes and a desire to produce authentic wines. The Corcelette vines produce light, fruity wines.

Vinification

Traditional whole bunch vinification, with semi-carbonic maceration and 9 days in vats. Aged in cement vats.

Tasting

Its silky texture makes it a perfect accompaniment to roast white meats, veal blanquette or quail with grapes.

Serving suggestions

A cru with a subtle cherry nose and a slender, silky structure. Corcelette comes from a granite sand terroir, which gives the Gamay its elegance and lightness.
