



# Chapelle de Brivazac

## Vineyard

Burned during the revolution, the Château de Barbe was rebuilt at the same time as the Grand Théâtre de Bordeaux, by Victor Louis. It is a superb residence, which overlooks the Gironde and is surrounded by its vineyard in one piece. It is made up of 42 hectares of limestone hillsides in the Côtes de Bourg appellation, 12 ha in the Bordeaux appellation, and 13 ha in the Bordeaux Supérieur appellation, on the edge of the estuary, where the “Chapelle de Brivazac” is produced.

## Tasting

It is a well-balanced wine, with a full nose dominated by fruit. It reveals a round mouth, beautiful substance and coated tannins.

Grape variety: 75% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc, 5% Malbec

Taste and flavor: Powerful and robustAlcohol content: 14°

Allergen: Sulphites

#### Service advice

Served at 15-17°C, this Bordeaux goes perfectly with red meats, grilled lamb, but also terrines and rillettes, and even roast poultry.
