



Beaune Champimonts 1^{er} Cru Domaine Chanson

Grape variety: Massale selection Pinot Noir planted in 1951.

Soil: Very loamy clay-limestone, refreshed by the northern winds from the Combe de Bouze... very slow maturity of the Pinot preserving the aromas of fresh red fruits (black cherry, raspberry)

Location: On the hillside south of Beaune, this 2-hectare vineyard of Domaine Chanson is located mid-slope, facing east.

Tasting: Beautiful ruby color. Aromas of ripe cherries with notes of peony, violet. Slight hint of vanilla. Well balanced and complex with very pure fruit. Dense texture. Fine-grained tannins. Good length on the fruit.

Food and wine pairings: Red meats, grilled or roasted (baked beef fillet, Rossini tournedos). All regional cheeses (Epoisse, Citeaux, Langres). Chocolate dessert or griottine giboulée.
