Grape variety: Pinot Noir

Soil: Clay-limestone

Location: In the heart of the Côte Chalonnaise, south of the Côte de Beaune, the Mercurey vineyard is mainly planted with Pinot Noir. The vineyard is located on the slopes facing South-East.

Tasting: Beautiful ruby color. Scent of violets with very fresh aromas of red cherry, strawberry and strawberry jam with a touch of vanilla. Well balanced and complex. Crunchy and dense texture. Well integrated tannins. Very nice length, full of generosity.

Food and wine pairings: Charcuterie, pies, red and white meats, poultry, regional cheeses (Citeaux, Langres, Epoisses)
