



Savigny-Les-Beaune Blanc 1er Cru Hauts Marconnets Domaine Chanson

Grape variety: Chardonnay

Soil: Sandy soil on limestone marls

Location: White wines from Savigny are rare, the vineyard mainly producing red wines. The particular nature of the soil of this "Hauts Marconnets" vineyard, with a high proportion of limestone marl and sand, encouraged Chanson to plant the vines with Chardonnay rather than Pinot Noir. The 2.20 hectare vineyard is ideally located at the top of the Savigny hillside, facing east.

The white wines are elegant with floral notes and well balanced when tasting.

Tasting: Beautiful gold color. Floral notes (acacia and hawthorn) with aromas of yellow-fleshed fruits and a slightly smoky note. Well balanced and precise. Dense and generous texture. Long finish with notes of almonds and vanilla

Food and wine pairings: Foie gras, seafood, just-snacked scallops, fish as well as regional cheeses (Citeaux, Epoisses) or even an old Comté.
