



Domaine Chanson - Pernand-Vergelesses Rouge 1er Cru Les Vergelesses

Grape variety: Pinot Noir

Soil: Very deep and dense. Clayey and a little stony at the top of the plot, very clayey and loamy at the bottom of the plot.

Location: South of the Corton hill, Chanson owns 5.4 hectares in "les Vergelesses", the most famous Premier Cru which gave its name to the village of Pernand.

Tasting: Purple color. Intense aromas of small black fruits (blackcurrant, cherry and blackberry) with notes of spices and roasting. Intense and powerful. Deep texture with a powerful tannin structure. Long and ample finish.

Food and wine pairings: Grilled entrecôte, red meats, game and all regional cheeses (Brillat-Savarin, Epoisses, Citeaux, Langres).
