GEOGRAPHICAL DESCRIPTION

From Dijon to Corgoloin the Côte de Nuits extends over twenty kilometers. It is a thin strip of vineyards no wider than a kilometer which covers an area of 1500 hectares.

GEOLOGICAL DESCRIPTION

This wine comes from vines located in the north of the GevreyChambertin appellation, next to an old cloister, that of the sisters of the same name.

The soil is clay-limestone, dry and light, the subsoil is stony and draining.
