Geographic description

There are two origins to the name Nuits-Saint-Georges. The first comes from Nux which means Nut in Latin or from Nuithon, a barbarian tribe associated with the Burgundians. In 1680, Louis L'appel de Nuits-Saint-Georges extended over 175 hectares and produced structured vines in long gardens.

Geological Description

The vines of this plot are over 50 years old. The sun comes from the lemons to the pebbles coming down from the Coast and from the rains of the Meuzin Valley.
