



Alphonse Mellot - Sancerre

Vineyard

Alphonse Mellot father and son (respectively 18th and 19th of the name) create some of the finest biodynamic wines of the Sancerre appellation. The estate covers 50 ha, 35 ha of Sauvignon and 15 ha of Pinot Noir. This vintage comes from vines that grew on Kimmeridgian marl limestone soils known as Saint Doulchard over 3 hectares.

Winemaking

The wine is aged 1/3 in new demi-muids and 2/3 in vats for 8 months, then in bulk for 2 to 3 months. Bottling is carried out at the property depending on the moons.

Tasting

We discover a pretty gold color with green highlights. On the nose, we recognize white flowers and citrus fruits. The palate is lively and refreshing.

It goes well with fish tartare, smoked salmon, beef bourguignon, or a chanterelle omelette.
