



Château Smith Haut Lafitte rouge Cru Classé

Smith Haut Lafitte is a very dark, almost black red wine. The nose expresses a bouquet of very fresh, very crunchy black fruits and red fruits: blackberries, blueberries, raspberries, cherries... When shaken, the nose reveals itself to be more complex with notes of spices and cedar, licorice combined with notes of violet and a touch of flint. The palate is frank, dynamic, powerful, dense, distinguished.

The tannins are concentrated, creamy and smooth. They give great length and a beautiful texture to this wine.

We find crunchy and ripe fruits on the palate accompanied by a spicier dimension with licorice, citron, cloves and a very beautiful finish with floral and mineral notes.

Yield: 35 hl/ha, before selection of the three wines:

Château Smith Haut Lafitte, Les Hauts de Smith and Le Petit Haut Lafitte. Blend 63% Cabernet Sauvignon 33% Merlot 2% Cabernet Franc 2% Petit Verdot

Vinification: whole berries in small wooden vats at 28°C, extraction carried out by manual punching down.

Aging for 18 months in barrels (60% new barrels made in our integrated cooperage), aging on lees, a single racking then aging adjusted for each wine.
Age of vines: 38 years
