Domaine du Haut Marchand. This appellation is one of the satellites of Saint-Emilion to the north east of Libourne. In the extension of the vineyards of Pomerol and Saint-Emilion, towards the north. Full-bodied wines, good for keeping

This wine has a brilliant color and is enhanced with purple reflections. It offers an aroma of red fruits. With a piece of beef or a beef bourguignon wine with a red wine from Domaine du Haut Marchand

On the palate, Montagne-Saint-Émilion is a powerful wine with a nice balance between acidity and tannins.

This vintage has a better score than all the other years of this wine
