Château La Commanderie is a superb, deep purple color with violet reflections. The nose is delicious, with scents of wild strawberries, blackberries and blackcurrants combined with fine notes of chocolate. The palate is fruity, juicy and offers a very nice balance with fine and polished tannins. Château La Commanderie is a brilliant wine, very balanced with remarkable fruitiness.

Château La Commanderie will witness more intimate moments, as a couple or between parents and "grown-up" children to celebrate a special date, a new beginning, a reunion...

The history of Château La Commanderie and that of Clos des Jacobins have been linked since the mid-1980s when the former owner of the latter acquired Château la Commanderie. Magali & Thibaut Decoster have been operating the 2 crus since 2005. Immediately, we carried out soil and plot studies, significant investments in production tools, uprooting and replanting phases, development and restoration work. renovation. This very quickly confirmed the exceptional qualities of the vintage. The work carried out resulted in Château la Commanderie being classified as a Grand Cru Classé de Saint-Émilion in 2012.
