The 70 hectare estate downstream from Cahors is spread over different terraces of clay-siliceous and clay-limestone soils above the lot

Tasting

The dress is dark. This wine is fruity, with aromas of cherry, blueberry and blackberry. It is fresh and dense. On the palate, it has a roundness with lots of fruit and good length.

Grape variety: 85% Malbec, 15% Merlot

Taste and flavor: Soft and velvety

Alcohol content: 14°

Allergen: Sulphites

Service advice

Serve at 15°C when young, and around 17°C when mature, with duck in orange sauce, poultry with spices, beef or white meat in sauce. It will pair perfectly with cheese or a chocolate dessert.
