Traditional in a “plotted” vat room
Long vatting: 25 days
Malolactic fermentation in French oak barrels
Aging for 18 months in new barrels

TASTING NOTES

The nose is expressive and intense, both minty and peppery, complemented by notes of very ripe black fruits.

The attack on the palate presents a lot of volume with a nice sweetness. There are aromas of candied fruits accompanied by liquorice.

The finish is long, with elegant tannins, for a balanced and powerful whole.

TASTING ADVICE

To be enjoyed with guinea fowl, ducks, game (venison, wood pigeon salmi), and dark chocolate cake.

To decant before serving
